Consider applying for our scholarship(s) .The National Police Relief Grand Association is offering a scholarship assistance program for those students that are a senior in high school and have a letter of acceptance to an accredited college or university, and those students who are already attending a accredited college or university and seek further assistance. A copy of your senior high school ID or your college or university before finalizing the process.

All members are reminded that you must be a parent or guardian and a good dues standing member of the National Police Relief Grand Association. Also be aware that the application must be postmarked no later than March 1st of the year of application.

In order to apply for the scholarship assistance program, you must contact the National Police Relief Grand Association office directly or download it from our website, or it can be mailed to you. The awards are based on scholastic merit, economic need, and the applicants stated goals in life. Each applicant must supply senior year high school grades or college or university transcripts. Seniors: a copy of an acceptance letter from an accredited college or university for the following year. They are not required to be law enforcement hopefuls but had to pledge to complete all two/four years of study.

President and committee members will act as judges in the scholarship. To keep the process anonymous, each candidate is assigned a number so that names and other identifying information is kept unknown during the judging process.

The recipient(s) now must maintain at least a B average in order to reapply each year to be considered for the following year's scholarship. We congratulate these potential individuals and wish them luck in their future endeavors.
